

Post Operative Instructions

1. Discomfort is expected to worsen over the next three days. On the fourth day, symptoms usually start to improve. Do NOT restore tooth until pain is gone.

2. Call Dr. Bui if you experience any of the following:
 - Infection
 - Bruising
 - Swelling
 - Numbness or tingling after 24 hours
 - Pain persisting or worsening after 2 weeks

3. Follow post operative Instructions as follows:
 - *If* an antibiotic was prescribed, take as directed on bottle label
 - Take Ibuprofen 600 mg three times a day for at least the first three days
 - Avoid chewing until numbness is gone and sensation has returned to normal
 - Do not chew on hard or sticky foods to avoid damage to temporary filling
 - If the filling should fall out return to office immediately to replace
 - Return to general dentist for continuation of treatment
